


Tami's Talks





I would like to take this opportunity to thank all of you for your continued patronage. October 1st is my one year anniversary date as the Culinary Manager here at Engel Haus. I wanted to thank all of you for all of your kind words and support over the past year.



After my first year, I feel that have a better understanding of what our residents want, and I would like to announce some of my plans to change our dining program to better fit the needs of our residents.

Starting October 1st. We will be changing our dining hours to better suit the needs of our residents:

Breakfast 7:30 AM-9:00 AM

Lunch 11:30 AM- 12:30 PM

Supper 4:30 PM-5:30 PM

I also have been working on a training program to improve our service standards, as well as the supervisory structure of our dining program to provide more supervision in the dining room. I believe this will provide a better overall dining experience.

One of the other changes I would like to announce is the addition of a "Lighter Side" menu to act as a healthier choice menu. This menu will be offered as an alternative to every meal service, and will be found on the back side of every weekly menu. In addition we have now made available a variety of low sodium soups, and sugar free juice (Strawberry Raspberry). These items are available for you to order at any meal service. The lighter side menu will begin with October's weekly menu.

Lastly, we will be revamping the fall bistro menu. This alternative menu will feature some of the items that many of you had requested, along with some seasonal favorites. Look for this menu to be distributed in October.
