Someone was really thinking when they put a water line in such a handy place! Feel free to take a walk and watch the beautiful flowers and vegetables grow.



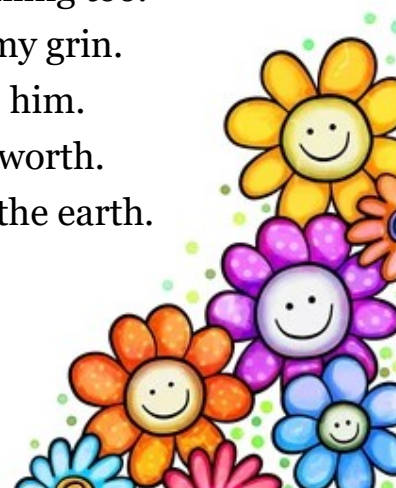
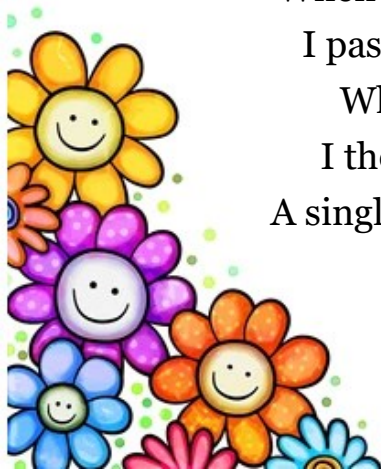
