



Grandparent / Phone Scam

Minnesota grandparents continue to report a scam where a con artist impersonates a grandchild in distress. The con artist exploits the love and generosity of the grandparent by pretending to be a grandchild in trouble and in need of emergency funds. The fraudster then convinces the grandparent that they are assisting a grandchild by paying for transportation home from a foreign country, medical treatment, or bail. Some grandparents - willing to come to the aid of a grandchild in need - set aside their reservations and quickly wire money to the impostor. The con artist may ask the grandparents not to contact the parents out of embarrassment or because the need is too urgent, helping the con artist avoid detection

If you receive any suspicious calls requesting payments or personal information - Do not give it out. Contact the Police or front desk for assistance.



Summer Strawberries & Grape Romanoff

1 16oz package strawberries, cleaned, washed and cut in halves/quarters

1 bag red grapes, cleaned and washed 16oz of Sour Cream or Low-fat Greek Yogurt

1/2 cup light brown sugar

2 drops of vanilla extract

In a large bowl mix together, sour cream, brown sugar and vanilla extract. Add grapes/ strawberries (be sure they have dried) and mix well. Serve
